The US Department of Energy (DOE)'s Advanced Research Projects Agency-Energy (ARPA-E) has a program dedicated to research on storage that can provide power for long durations (10-100 hours). Extended discharge of storage systems can enable long-lasting backup power and even greater integration of renewable energy.

The Long Duration Storage Shot establishes a target to reduce the cost of grid-scale energy storage by 90% for systems that deliver 10+ hours of duration within the decade. Energy storage has the potential to accelerate full decarbonization of the electric grid.

The 2022 Cost and Performance Assessment analyzes storage system at additional 24- and 100-hour durations. In September 2021, DOE launched the Long-Duration Storage Shot which aims ...

The chart below, from an E3 study examining reliability requirements on a deeply decarbonized California grid, shows that 10-hour storage has a higher ELCC value than 4-hour storage, particularly at lower energy storage penetrations. But no matter the duration, the ELCC of energy storage eventually declines when you add enough to the grid.

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The Long-Duration Energy Storage (LDES) portfolio will validate new energy storage technologies and enhance the capabilities of customers and communities to integrate grid storage more effectively. While energy storage technologies are often defined in terms of duration (i.e., a four-hour battery), a system's duration varies at the rate at which it is discharged. A system rated at 1 MW/4 MWh, for example, may only last for four hours or fewer when discharged at its maximum power rating.

The current state of energy storage. Currently, the utility-scale energy storage market is largely dominated by 4-hour lithium-ion batteries, which constitute for 90% of the estimated 9 GW utility-scale battery capacity in the United States by the end of 2022 (not including pumped storage hydropower).
