



150 kwh of electricity storage

The cost of the battery needs to be reduced to less than \$100 kWh⁻¹ and the cost of the whole battery system (including the battery management system, BMS) reduced to less than \$150 kWh⁻¹. The total battery system cost will be \$15,000 for a 100 kWh vehicle.

For energy storage, the capital cost should also include battery management systems, inverters and installation. The net capital cost of Li-ion batteries is still higher than \$400 kWh⁻¹ storage. The real cost of energy storage is the LCC, which is the amount of electricity stored and dispatched divided by the total capital and operation cost .

In 3 hours, that is 1.5 kWh. To get the dollar amount, we need to multiply electric consumption by the cost of electricity. If we presume \$0.1319 per kWh electricity cost, one wash will cost us: Electricity Cost = 1.5 kWh * \$0.1319/kWh = \$0.20. Grid-scale battery costs can be measured in $\$/\text{kW}$ or $\$/\text{kWh}$ terms. Thinking in kW terms is more helpful for modelling grid resiliency. A good rule of thumb is that grid-scale lithium ion batteries will have 4-hours of



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storage duration, as this minimizes per kW costs and maximizes the revenue potential from power price arbitrage.

Here, we construct experience curves to project future prices for 11 electrical energy storage technologies. We find that, regardless of technology, capital costs are on a trajectory towards US\$340 /kWh for installed stationary systems and US\$175 /kWh for battery packs once 1 TWh of capacity is installed for each technology.
