

18 years of energy storage field

Battery energy storage systems are game-changers in the transition to renewable energy, but also relatively new to the renewable energy space. According to the research report released at the "Energy Storage Industry 2023 Review and 2024 Outlook" conference, the scale of new grid-connected energy storage projects in China will reach 22.8GW/49.1GWh in 2023, nearly three times the new installed capacity of 7.8GW/16.3GWh in 2022.
