China is solidifying its position as the largest energy storage market in the world for the rest of the decade.

While energy storage technologies are often defined in terms of duration (i.e., a four-hour battery), a system's duration varies at the rate at which it is discharged. A system rated at 1 MW/4 MWh, for example, may only last for four hours or fewer when discharged at its maximum power rating.

A battery energy storage system (BESS) is an electrochemical device that charges (or collects energy) from the grid or a power plant and then discharges that energy at a later time to provide electricity or other grid services when needed.

The Long Duration Storage Energy Earthshot establishes a target to reduce the cost of grid-scale energy

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storage by 90% for systems that deliver 10+ hours of duration within the decade. Energy storage has the potential to accelerate full decarbonization of the electric grid.
