

In late April, a MW-scale molten salt hydroxide energy storage project was inaugurated in Denmark, also the first of its scale in the world, technology provider Hyme claimed. Two months prior to that, thermal energy storage startup Antora raised US\$150 million to commercialise its tech which uses heat stored in blocks of carbon material.

An AVIC Securities report projected major growth for China's power storage sector in the years to come: The country's electrochemical power storage scale is likely to reach 55.9 gigawatts by 2025-16 times higher than that of 2020-and the power storage development can generate a 100-billion-yuan (US\$15.5 billion) market in the near future.

Looking ahead to 2024, TrendForce anticipates a robust growth in China's new energy storage installations, projecting a substantial increase to 29.2 gigawatts and 66.3 gigawatt-hours. This ...

The new policy could mean that China overtakes the US as the energy storage leader in gigawatt terms by 2030, while requiring \$18bn investment to meet its 2025 target. Some uncertainties remain, including project economics, detailed policies and supply chain constraints, but we expect to see more policies backed with strong action to meet the goal.

MITECO launched two programmes, with the first one seeking either standalone projects or thermal energy storage projects with a budget of EUR180 million, of which EUR30 million for thermal energy storage alone. A DC BESS container fully manufactured in the US sits at an average price of US\$256/kWh in 2023 for a 2024/25 delivery, while one manufactured in China for US delivery in 2025 sits at US\$218/kWh, Clean Energy Associates (CEA) said.



By the close of 2023, China had notched up an impressive cumulative installed capacity of 31.39GW/66.87GWh in new energy storage projects, surpassing the 14th Five-Year Plan target two years ahead of schedule.

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
