



Abnormal leakage of abs pump accumulator

Any kind of discernible frequency of cycling of the accumulator pump is not normal, and means that one of the two components has failed. You've even got the DTC to prove it. #2 Mr. F, Aug 13, 2023

The accumulator is a component of the vehicle"s brake hydraulic system that stores hydraulic pressure to assist in brake application. When there is an abnormal leak of pressure in the accumulator, it can lead to a variety of issues that affect the vehicle"s braking performance and safety. Inspect the accumulator and brake system for leaks and damage. Replace damaged accumulator seals or bladder. Repair or replace any corroded or rusted accumulator components. Test the brake system to ensure proper pressure and functionality. Reset the fault code and perform a final check to confirm the issue has been resolved.

If not addressed, the abnormal leak of accumulator pressure can lead to further damage to the braking system and other related components. NOTE: The causes shown may not be a complete list of all potential problems, and it is possible that there may be other causes.

Hey all, I have an 08" Highlander Hybrid Limited 3.3l (205,xxx miles) with current ABS codes C1391 (Abnormal Leak in Accumulator) and past ABS codes C1380 (Stop Light Relay System), C1241 (Low or high Power Supply Voltage), and a C1532 (ECU Malfunction).

That's the sound of your brake accumulator pump having to repeatedly run because the brake pressure won't hold, which is what the C1391 already was telling you. Having to run every 7 or 8 seconds like that with nobody using the brakes is bad. When your brakes work right, the pressure can hold up for hours if the brakes aren't being used.

ABS/VSC/TRAC: C1391 (Current) - Abnormal Leak of ACC Press And I've read about it being a skid control ecu issue or the actuator? The symptoms I have is I am hearing strange noises (but doesn't seem like squeakiness from pump), but main thing is on a cold start you hear a BEEEEP BEEEEEEEEEEEEEP that lasts about 10 seconds or 15 seconds.
