

# Accumulator pneumatic pump

All the fluid would always flow through the accumulator dampening the vibrations produced by the pump. Because the accumulator stores energy, you will want to keep the accumulator on the high-pressure side of the system. A piston-style accumulator is best placed close to devices that cause pulsations to dampen those pulses. Figure 4.

In years gone by this was achieved using a deadweight. However, spring-type accumulators or hydro-pneumatic type accumulators are still used in modern hydraulic applications. Hydro-pneumatic accumulators, which use hydraulic fluid to compress nitrogen gas and hence the name hydro-pneumatic, are the predominant accumulator type.

Let's start with - "What is an Accumulator?" Think of an air balloon inserted into a bucket and apply a force to the balloon. You increase the pressure on the airside of the balloon. ... This pulsation is coming basically from the hydraulic pumps. So the accumulator will make a dampening on this pulsation and will stabilize your system ...

Air Pump Assembly. To provide high pressure operating fluid, one or more hydraulic pumps in the air pump assembly will be connected (parallel) to the accumulator for the BOP control system. ... 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Turn on the pumps. Wait 4 to 5 seconds for electric pumps, slightly longer (until the pump reaches a steady level of operation) for air pumps. Observe the accumulator pressure gauge. If the accumulator pressure gauge registers from 900 psi to 1100 psi, all accumulators have sufficient precharge pressure.

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When the 4-way valve is shifted to start the cylinder, the stored oil adds to the pump flow to give the cylinder a speed greater than from pump oil alone. The big advantage of accumulators on this type system is that a smaller (and less expensive) pump, electric motor, and control valve will do the same job as larger and more costly components.



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The circuit uses several accumulators to supplement pump flow because the dwell time is 45 sec. out of the 57.5-sec. cycle.
