4. Technology

More than 35% of the world's total energy consumption is made up of process heat in industrial applications. Fossil fuel is used for industrial process heat applications, providing 10% of the energy for the metal industry, 23% for the refining of petroleum, 80% for the pulp and paper industry, and 60% for the food processing industry.

Additionally, hydrogen - which is detailed separately - is an emerging technology that has potential for the seasonal storage of renewable energy.
