Hot water heat pump. Heating water is the second highest source of energy use in most households. Hot water heat pumps use a refrigeration cycle to extract heat from the air to heat the water. Running costs are about a third of those for an ordinary gas system and the payback period is between 4 and 6 years (ACT Government).
