

Air storage chamber in air energy storage

The traditional CAES consists mainly of important components such as compressors, a compressed air storage, combustion chambers, expanders and motor/generators. During energy storage process, the air enters the compressor from atmospheric environment and is compressed into high pressure air and stored in the compressed air storage.
