Hydroelectric power stations derive energy from moving water - and about 2% of overall electricity generation in the UK has been produced from these sources over the past 30 years. The three main types of hydroelectric power stations in the UK include storage schemes, run-of-river schemes and pumped storage.

Prompted by a severe electricity supply crisis in the mid-1990s, Armenia has revamped its energy sector over the past 20 years. Parts of the sector have been privatised, some companies have been restructured, most households now have access to gas, and cost-reflective tariffs have been introduced.

Armenia depends on imports to meet much of its energy needs, particularly natural gas from the Russian Federation. It is one of the few ex-Soviet republics to avoid significant energy subsidies, and it is the only country in the Caucasus region to possess a nuclear power plant.

An additional 65 hydropower stations are under construction. Once they start operating, small hydro power stations will meet 6 percent of the internal demand for electricity. Nuclear power provides 38% of the electricity in Armenia through one operating nuclear reactor, Unit 2 of Metsamor Nuclear Power Plant, which is a WWER-440 reactor with extra seismic reinforcement.

Most of the rest of Armenia's electricity is generated by the natural gas-fired thermal power plants in Yerevan (completed in 2010) and Hrazdan. Upon gaining independence, Armenia signed the European Energy Charter in December 1991, the charter is now known as the Energy Charter Treaty which promotes integration of global energy markets.

Pumped storage hydroelectric projects have been providing energy storage capacity in Italy and Switzerland since the 1890s. The UK has four pumped storage hydro power stations in Scotland and Wales, with a total capacity of 2.8 GW. The Dinorwig Hydro Power Station in Wales can switch from being fully shut down to operating at full capacity in ...

The amount of energy that can be generated by releasing a unit volume of water from any reservoir equals the multiplication of the water density (ρ), the gravitational constant (g), the potential head of the hydropower station, and the electricity conversion efficiency of the turbine.The efficiency depends on the water flow rate and the potential head available.
