

Bahrain's energy storage status

Given Bahrain's climate, solar energy is a vital part of the kingdom's clean energy mix, accounting for 93% of its renewable capacity in 2020. In November 2021 the government inaugurated the Batelco solar plant, which can produce some 1600 MW of power and is expected to reduce the country's carbon emissions by around 900 tonnes.

Together with a new supply pipeline from Saudi Arabia, an upcoming liquefied natural gas (LNG) import terminal, and new offshore production from KABB and northern Block 1, Bahrain's refinery modernisation programme could see the kingdom regain its position as a major energy provider for the region.

Bahrain is also beginning to ramp up investment in renewables as it works towards its goal of reaching net-zero carbon emissions by 2060. The spike in oil prices in early 2022 could offer further incentive for Bahrain to expand its green energy capabilities. In September 2021 Bahrain announced plans to restructure its oil and gas industry.

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Though Bahrain does not produce as much oil as its larger neighbours, the energy industry remains a vital part of the national economy. This has been helped by a large-scale oil and gas discovery in 2018 and the upgrade of the country's main refinery in Sitra.

The EIA reports that Bahrain's installed generation capacity is around 4 GW. Energy demand is growing rapidly in response to steady expansion of industrial and manufacturing industries and domestic population growth, particularly aluminium and petrochemicals, both of which rely on cheap supply of natural gas feedstock to underpin profitability.

Infrastructure is capital intensive and with low energy prices, investing in a long-term LNG facility in an energy-exporting country becomes unattractive. Over the past three years, the credit worthiness of MENA economies has deteriorated, with Bahrain downgraded by S&P from BBB investment grade in 2013 to BB- today.

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
