Thermal energy storage is a family of technologies in which a fluid, such as water or molten salt, or other material is used to store heat. This thermal storage material is then stored in an insulated tank until the energy is needed. The energy may be used directly for heating and cooling, or it can be used to generate electricity. ...

The basic principle of adsorption TES is shown in Fig. 1 for zeolite and water in a closed system, as investigated in this work.
