During periods of high power production, BESS store the excess energy. Then, during periods of low irradiance or wind, the stored energy powers the required



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equipment.

A full battery energy storage system can provide backup power in the event of an outage, guaranteeing business continuity. Battery systems can co-locate solar photovoltaic, wind turbines, and gas generation technologies.
