So when energy prices are higher, the battery discharges the hot air which warms water for the district heating system which is then pumped around homes, offices and even the local swimming pool.

Construction details of a sand battery can be found in the patent filed by inventor Vladan Petrović from Serbia. The inventor also calls it a "heat storage device for long-term heat storage of solar energy and other types of energy". Some thermal storage systems are soaking up waste heat rather than relying on electricity. Brenmiller Energy, for example, is building thermal batteries that can be charged up with heat or electricity, depending on the customer's needs.

Swedish public utility Vattenfall is also building a 200MW-rated thermal energy storage in Berlin. The heat storage tank can hold 56 million litres of water, which will be heated to 98°C to warm homes.

Thermal batteries allow utilities or customers to move energy from one time of day -- or even one time of year -- to another, said Murtaugh. Journalists tour the inside of Vattenfall's vast thermal tank to store hot water in Berlin, Germany. Thermal batteries work well with district heating, which is widespread in Europe.
