Local governments have also started to promote the NEV battery recycling sector. In one such example, the province of Jiangsu has set up 907 NEV battery recycling centres. Shanghai has initiated a full life cycle tracking and regulation system for NEV batteries. China currently has over 10,000 battery recycling centres across the country.

So companies around the world are scrambling to build battery recycling facilities, and more than 200 businesses now have a combined capacity to recycle more than 1 million metric tons (t) of EOL batteries per year, according to Circular Energy Storage, a London-based consultancy.

As large volumes of these batteries reach their end of life, the need for sustainable battery recycling and recovery of critical materials is a matter of utmost importance. Global reserves for critical LIB elements such as lithium, cobalt, and nickel will soon be outstripped by growing cumulative demands.

Several countries have regulations that cover lead battery recycling: Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica Mexico, Paraguay, and Peru. However, there are no analogous regulatory regimes for Li-ion batteries, meaning there is almost no infrastructure for recy-cling e-waste or batteries.
