A battery energy storage system (BESS) is an electrochemical device that charges (or collects energy) from the grid or a power plant and then discharges that energy at a later time

It can calculate the levelized cost of storage for specific designs for comparison with vanadium systems and with one another. Supercapacitors, which can charge/discharge at a much faster rate and at a greater frequency than lithium-ion batteries are now used to augment current battery storage for quick energy inputs and output. Graphene battery technology--or graphene-based supercapacitors--may be an alternative to lithium batteries in some applications.

Most battery-powered devices, from smartphones and tablets to electric vehicles and energy storage systems, rely on lithium-ion battery technology.
