Energy density corresponds to the energy accumulated in a unit volume or mass, taking into account dimensions of electrochemical energy storage system and its ability to store large amount of energy. On the other hand power density indicates how an electrochemical energy storage system is suitable for fast charging and discharging processes.

The research group investigates and develops materials and devices for electrochemical energy conversion and storage.
