At least 3 000 gigawatts (GW) of renewable power projects, of which 1 500 GW are in advanced stages, are waiting in grid connection queues - equivalent to five times the amount of solar PV and wind capacity added in 2022. This shows grids are becoming a bottleneck for transitions to net zero emissions.

Between 2021 and 2022, the capacity of renewable energy and storage waiting for grid connections increased by 40%, as investments in new renewable power projects outstripped those in grid connections.

The highest-risk bottleneck is projected to be in materials--specifically the supply of rare earth metals for magnets, with severe imbalances in magnets for predominantly offshore wind expected by the end of this decade.
