Grid energy storage is used to shift generation from times of peak load to off-peak hours. Power plants are



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able to run at their peak efficiency during nights and weekends. Supply-demand leveling strategies may be intended to reduce the cost of supplying peak power or to compensate for the intermittent generation of wind and solar power.

Battery energy storage systems (BESSes) act as reserve energy that can complement the existing grid to serve several different purposes. Potential grid applications are listed in Figure 1 and categorized as either power or energy-intensive, i.e., requiring a large energy reserve or high power capability.

ESS applications on power transmissions and distributions are estimated at around 16 % in 2025 worldwide, which can be reduced to around 14 % in 2030. For optimal power system operation, energy storage systems can be utilized as a DR unit for microgrid systems.
