

Brazil has been at the forefront of hydro-storage technology, building the first two pumped-hydro storage plant in the world in the 1940s, respectively the Pedreira and the Traição Dams. Nevertheless, due to unrelated environmental issues, local authorities prohibited water pumping from the feeding river, effectively limiting the use of the ...

According to the draft of the auction rules published by the Ministry of Mines and Energy, the procurement exercise will be held in June 2025 for systems with a power output of at least 30 MW that can store energy for at least four hours a day. The draft says that the contracts will cover a period of 10 years, with operation starting in July 2029.

Further details about Brazil's largest battery storage project to date have been revealed including its integrators and equipment providers.
