Battery storage costs have evolved rapidly over the past several years, necessitating an update to storage cost projections used in long-term planning models and other activities. This work documents the development of these projections, which are based on recent publications of storage costs.

In this work we describe the development of cost and performance projections for utility-scale lithium-ion battery systems, with a focus on 4-hour duration systems. The projections are ...

Financing and transaction costs - at current interest rates, these can be around 20% of total project costs. 1) Total battery energy storage project costs average £580k/MW. 68% of battery project costs range between £400k/MW and £700k/MW. When exclusively considering two-hour sites the median of battery project costs are £650k/MW.
