

Can iron store electricity

Massachusetts-based Form Energy is developing an iron-air battery technology, which uses oxygen from ambient air in a reversible reaction that converts iron to rust. The company claims its battery could store power for up to 100 hours. Its first installation will be a one-megawatt pilot plant in Minnesota, scheduled to be completed in 2023.

Domestic battery storage is a rapidly evolving technology which allows households to store electricity for later use. Domestic batteries are typically used alongside solar photovoltaic (PV) panels. Iron electrodes have several advantages: iron is the fourth-most-abundant metal on earth by mass, non-toxic, and can store 960 mAh of energy per gram of iron.
