High Energy Density. Lithium batteries can store more energy than Lead-acid batteries. Up to 4 times and a lead-acid battery with the same capacity can take up more than 10 times the space. Not only does this save space but it gives an electric car more range when running on Lithium batteries than it would on Lead Acid batteries.

The electric potential energy of a car battery can be measured in volts and is determined by the difference in electric potential between the battery's positive and negative terminals. This voltage, also known as electromotive force, reflects the battery's ability to move electrons through a circuit.

The world's capacity to make battery cells has expanded rapidly in recent years. Today, manufacturing operations globally can produce around 320 gigawatt-hours (GWh) of batteries per year for use in electric cars. This is well above the approximately 100 GWh of batteries required for the 2.1 million electric cars that were sold in 2019.
