Capacitors used for energy storage. Capacitors are devices which store electrical energy in the form of electrical charge accumulated on their plates. When a capacitor is connected to a power source, it accumulates energy which can be released when the capacitor is disconnected from the charging source, and in this respect they are similar to batteries.

When the triggering circuit turns on the electronic switch (in most cases, thyristors), the energy within capacitor C discharges into the ignition coil. Due to the limited energy stored in the capacitor and the low-inductance ignition coil used in CDI systems, the spark duration is relatively short compared to IDI systems.

A capacitor is a device that stores electrical charge. The simplest capacitor is the parallel plates capacitor, which holds two opposite charges that create a uniform electric field between the plates.. Therefore, the energy in a capacitor comes from the potential difference between the charges on its plates.

A piezo electric element only puts out 10 -12 KV if it has no load on it. If you connect one through a small bridge rectifier (They actually put out AC. One polarity on compression and the other on rebound) you can use the tiny current pulses to directly charge up a capacitor and use a common Zener diode across the capacitor as a voltage limiter.
