Since energy losses during storage are smaller for thermochemical energy storage than for sensible or latent TES, thermochemical energy storage has good potential for long-term storage applications . Supercapacitors offer high-power storage for electronics, while SMES offers lossless energy storage. Chemical energy storage uses bonds and electrolysis for sustainability. Chemical energy storage systems are sometimes classified according to the energy they consume, e.g., as electrochemical energy storage when they consume electrical energy, and as thermochemical energy storage when they consume thermal energy.
