Technically, "new energy storage" in the Chinese market always refers to any energy storage solutions other than the conventional and dominant pumped hydro storage method. But the industry mostly looked to battery cells, fuel cells and other frontier technologies (such as compressed air, flywheel, and super-capacitor) for the job in the past.

Clearly, the predominant types of energy storage installations in China at present are still mandated installations for renewable energy and standalone energy storage. The primary driver behind the surge in domestic energy storage installations is the mandatory installation requirements.

As of the end of 2022, lithium-ion battery energy storage took up 94.5 percent of China's new energy storage installed capacity, followed by compressed air energy storage (2 percent), lead-acid (carbon) battery energy storage (1.7 percent), flow battery energy storage (1.6 percent) and other technical routes (0.2 percent).

Implementing large-scale commercial development of energy storage in China will require significant effort from power grid enterprises to promote grid connection, dispatching, and trading mechanisms, and also share the responsibility of the regulatory authority for energy storage safety risks to ensure the high-quality application of energy ...
