



China new market group energy storage

According to the research report released at the "Energy Storage Industry 2023 Review and 2024 Outlook" conference, the scale of new grid-connected energy storage projects in China will reach 22.8GW/49.1GWh in 2023, nearly three times the new installed capacity of 7.8GW/16.3GWh in 2022.

Commenting on China's new energy market, Tesla's vice president Tao Lin said China boasts vast market potential and complete industrial chains. After the groundbreaking ceremony Thursday, Tesla signed a deal with Shanghai Lingang Economic Development (Group) Co., Ltd., securing the first batch of orders for its Megapacks in China.

As of the first half of 2023, the world added 27.3 GWh of installed energy storage capacity on the utility-scale power generation side plus the C& I sector and 7.3 GWh in the residential sector, totaling 34.6 GW, equaling 80% of the 44 GWh addition last year. Despite a global installation boom, regional markets develop at varying paces.

According to incomplete statistics from CNESA DataLink Global Energy Storage Database, by the end of June 2023, the cumulative installed capacity of electrical energy storage projects commissioned in China was 70.2GW, with a year-on-year increase of 44%.

2. Energy Storage Inverter Provider Rankings. In 2019, among new operational electrochemical energy storage projects in China, the top 10 energy storage inverter providers in terms of installed capacity were Sungrow, Kelong, NR Electric, Sinexcel, CLOU Electronics, Soaring, KLNE, Sineng, XJ Group Corporation, and Zhiguang Energy Storage.

Their new energy-storage capacity in 2022 accounted for 86 percent of the global total, up 6 percentage points from 2021. The CNESA report estimated that China's cumulative installed capacity of new energy storage in 2027 may reach 138.4 gigawatts if the country's provincial-level regions achieve their targets of



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energy-storage construction.

According to CNESA's research team therefore, 38% of global new energy storage capacity addition was in China, making it the world's leader for the year so far. In addition to the significant ramp-up in capacity, CNESA's monthly market update reported several significant steps forward in China alongside some major project news.
