Photovoltaics continued to lead job growth in the global renewables sector last year, accounting for a total of 7.2 million jobs around the world, with nearly 64% of those, or 4.5 million, in China ...

It is divided into two parts: offshore and onshore. The offshore part consists of over 3.3 million photovoltaic modules forming 480 arrays, while the onshore part is a 400-megawatt-hour energy storage. A company under the China National Nuclear Corporation (CNNC) is expected to manage the power plant, whose onshore part will finish by late June.

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
