Shore power service charge is the cost of shore power operation and maintenance charged by the port, with the unit of yuan / kWh. It is a part of the cost of ship's using shore power, mainly including the purchase cost of shore power equipment for port investment and construction, shore power operation and labor cost, operation income, etc.

As there is no government subsidy for using shore power at the Foshan port, withdrawing power from shore power facilities at the port costs USD 0.47 per kilowatt-hour, which is relatively high.
