The five universal circuit breaker components are: Contacts - Allows the current to flow through the circuit breaker when closed. Arc extinguisher - Extinguishes an arc when the circuit breaker interrupts a fault. Trip unit - Opens the operating mechanism in the event of a prolonged overload or short circuit.

As the plunger continues its forward motion, it eventually strikes the latch, causing it to open, as illustrated in Case "c" subsequently, the pole of the circuit breaker begins to open, as depicted in Case "d", eventually reaching a fully opened position in Case "e"..
