

US coal power plants generally stockpile much more coal than they consume in a month, with more than 90% of coal-fired power plants currently having enough coal on hand to generate electricity for 60 days or more. The EIA estimates days of burn as the number of days a sample of coal plants can generate electricity using their current stockpiles.
