Coal underground thermal energy storage (CUTES) is a form of energy storage that makes extensive use of the underground highways in closed mines as a place to store energy and to offer heating and cooling in the winter and summer months, respectively.

In the coal mine, belt conveyors (BCs) are deployed to deliver raw coal with energy consumption, which are coupled with the energy system and transportation network in a coal mine. In order to improve the energy efficiency of the BCs, some studies have been conducted to obtain the optimal control of the BC system.
