Fig. 15 presents the Pareto frontiers of the CSP system and PV plant with the energy-storage system in the cost-reduction scenarios. As in the current scenarios, the CSP system has excellent flexibility and reliability performance, which results in the minimum LPSP of 0.029 and the corresponding LCOE of 0.244 USD/kWh.

The values considered for the solar resources have been 2300 and 2850 kW h/m²/year for PV and CSP systems, respectively (see Section 4.4.1).

PV systems generally have a lower environmental footprint compared to CSP technologies. The manufacturing process of PV panels, while energy-intensive, has become more sustainable with advancements

in recycling and the use of cleaner energy sources in production.
