IBC 2015 Section 1020 lists requirements for construction and fire-resistance detailing of corridor walls. 1020.1 Construction. Corridors shall be fire-resistance rated in accordance with Table 1020.1. The corridor walls required to be fire-resistance-rated shall comply with Section 708 for fire partitions.

Where the corridor ceiling is constructed as required for the corridor walls, the walls shall be permitted to terminate at the upper membrane of such ceiling assembly. Exception 3 allows for a corridor to be constructed in a "tunnel" fashion--with rated walls and a rated top.

Due to the typical thinner floor structure in the corridor, this would result in the membrane on the corridor side of the wall extending higher than the gypsum on the non-corridor side of the corridor wall as shown below. Other options for detailing this condition are given as exceptions to IBC 708.4.
