Most of the literature only report the cost of manufacturing lithium-ion (Li-ion) battery systems for hybrid vehicles in terms of dollars per kilowatt-hour of energy storage (\$/kWh). The battery is the most expensive component in an electric vehicle. Around 80% of the cost of a PHEV-40's drive system is due to the battery pack. [F& S 2009a]
