

Cost per watt of new energy storage

Energy storage system costs stay above \$300/kWh for a turnkey four-hour duration system. In 2022, rising raw material and component prices led to the first increase in energy storage system costs since BNEF started its ESS cost survey in 2017. Costs are expected to remain high in 2023 before dropping in 2024.

Building a solar farm costs about \$0.80 to \$1.36 per watt to install, not including the cost of land. By acreage, building a solar farm typically costs between \$400,000 and \$500,000 per acre. If you live on a large plot of land, you might consider building a solar farm as a new business venture.

When thinking about the overall cost of a solar energy system, it's vital to keep in mind that the battery storage isn't the only expense. How much do solar panels cost on average? Most people will need to spend between \$16,500 and \$21,000 for solar panels, with the national average solar installation costing about \$19,000.. Most of the time, you'll see solar system costs listed as the cost per watt of solar installed so you can easily compare prices between quotes for different system sizes.

It's important to note that battery prices vary based on the type of equipment, product availability, and location.
