

Costa Rica's new energy storage policy

On a global scale, Costa Rica's wind energy efforts are also noteworthy. While the country's total installed wind power capacity may be relatively small compared to leading nations like China, the United States, and Germany, Costa Rica's commitment to renewable energy and its ambitious goals for carbon neutrality set it apart.

In those cases, the owner can install storage batteries for later use. Also, it eliminates the 49% rule for new contracts and forces electricity distribution companies to publish the percentage of caps for each circuit. Another variation is that a person or company could generate energy in one location, but consume it in another.
