By using DC motor coupling, these systems avoid the need for power conversion and achieve greater efficiency.

The BLDC motor is coupled with a dynamometer as shown in Fig. 14. The motor speed is controlled by software provided for the dynamometer setup. In the absence of any energy storage effects (a physically unrealisable condition), the current in a resistor of value R is I when the voltage across it is V , in accordance with the relation $I = V/R$. If a steady p.d. V be suddenly applied to a resistor R , the current instantaneously assumes the value given, and energy is expended at the rate $P = I^2 R$ watts, continuously.

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
