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If operated correctly, it is possible for a large commercial building, industrial facility, or other large energy user to use energy storage to lower their energy bill, while simultaneously receiving additional revenue for participating in a demand response program from their utility or the NYISO.

Flexibility should be at the core of policy design: the first step needs to be a whole-system assessment of flexibility requirements that compares the case for different types of grid-scale storage with other options such as demand response, power plant retrofits, smart grid measures and other technologies that raise overall flexibility.

However, the demand response resources and energy storage systems do not necessarily guarantee additional



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benefits based on the applied period when both are operated simultaneously, i.e., if the energy storage system is used only to increase the performance reliability of demand response resources, the benefit decreases.
