

Development of energy storage sites in the uk

During 2022, the operational capacity of energy storage sites in the UK increased by almost 800MWh, the largest annual deployment figure so far. In the first quarter of 2022, the first 50MW/100MWh (50MW with a 2-hour ...

In May last year, it sold two battery energy storage system (BESS) projects in southern England to Foresight Energy Infrastructure Partners: Sundon BESS, a 49.5MW project north of London that will connect with National Grid's Energy Park initiative; and Warley BESS, a 57MW project in Essex. Both sites have grid connection dates in 2024.

All data is taken from our UK Battery Storage Project Database report. Currently, the total operational capacity for battery storage in the UK is 1.3GW with 130MW having been commissioned already this year. The graphic below shows a flow diagram that summarises the remaining 2021 site prospects, within the total pipeline of 686 sites.
