The only downside of this type of energy storage system is the high capital cost involved with buying and installing the main components. The characteristics exhibited by mechanical energy storage systems makes them ideal for load levelling as well as storage. A technology already considered as being mature is pumped hydro-energy storage.

Hydroelectric power is a form of renewable energy in which electricity is produced from generators driven by turbines that convert the potential energy of moving water into mechanical energy. Hydroelectric power plants usually are located in dams that impound rivers, though tidal action is used in some coastal areas.

Pump storage hydropower - PSH (pumped-storage hydroelectricity) or PHES (pumped hydroelectric energy storage) is a type of hydroelectric energy storage used for load balancing in electric power systems. Water pumped from a lower-elevation reservoir to a higher elevation is used to store energy in the form of gravitational potential energy.

One of the main disadvantages associated with this type of storage system is the need for the heating process to cause expansion.

However, the disadvantages of these electrochemical energy storage systems include the following: life time reduction at temperatures below 0°C (at - 20°C for lithium-ion batteries, the number of charge-discharge cycles can be reduced by 50%). Lead-acid batteries are used as short- and medium-term energy storage systems.
