



Distributed energy storage course

OE partnered with energy storage industry members, national laboratories, and higher education institutions to analyze emergent energy storage technologies. Energy storage is critical in distributed energy systems to decouple the time of energy production from the time of power use. By using energy storage, consumers deploying DER systems like rooftop solar can, for example, generate power when it's sunny out and deploy it later during the peak of energy demand in the evening.

One of the most significant changes to electricity systems around the world has been the emergence of new technologies that can support locally-owned facilities for electricity generation, control and storage. These technologies, often referred to as Distributed Energy Resources (DERs), are transforming the way communities meet their energy needs.

It covers distributed renewable generation including wind, solar and hydro plants, various energy storage technologies as well as the impact of modern loads such as electric vehicles, heat pumps and LED lighting on the power system. It introduces the concepts of load management, demand response and active network management.
