Thermal energy is stored solely through a change of temperature of the storage medium. The capacity of a storage system is defined by the specific heat capacity and the mass of the medium used. Latent heat storage is accomplished by using phase change materials (PCMs) as storage media.

In its draft national electricity plan, released in September 2022, India has included ambitious targets for the development of battery energy storage. In March 2023, the European Commission published a series of recommendations on policy actions to support greater deployment of electricity storage in the European Union.

A lot of the clean energy will be from renewable, natural sources such as wind, solar and hydro (water) power. The government's British energy security strategy sets ambitions for 50GW of offshore wind power generation by 2030, with much of this coming from the North Sea but also from offshore wind farms in other coastal locations around England and Wales.

The most widely deployed type of storage for electrical energy is pumped hydro storage. Their costs, revenues, and profits, related to full-load hours per year are illustrated in Figure 5, taking into account also the losses of the pumped hydro storage.

Electricity is used to compress air and store it in either an underground structure or an above-ground system of vessels or pipes. When needed the compressed air is mixed with natural gas, burned and expanded in a modified gas turbine. Typical underground storage options are caverns, aquifers or abandoned mines.

Battery storage has begun to play a significant role in the shift away from energy grid reliance on fossil fuels (Grid Status, 2024). Batteries have allowed for increased use of solar and wind power, but the rebound effects of new energy storage technologies are transforming landscapes (Reimers et al., 2021; Turley et al., 2022).

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Modern energy storage systems such as electric double layer capacitor (EDLC) and lithium-ion batteries have a great deal of potential for a wide range of applications. Carbon-derived materials are the most flexible and fundamental materials for the storage and conversion of modern energy.
