At present, the thickness of the copper foil of the new energy vehicle is 8~12mm, and the quality of the whole vehicle copper foil is more than 10kg. The smaller the thickness of the lithium copper foil, the lighter ...

In order to ensure the stability of the current collector in the battery, the purity of both is required to be above 98%. There are three reasons why the positive electrode of lithium ion battery uses aluminum foil and the negative electrode uses copper foil: 1 pper foil and aluminum foil have good conductivity, soft texture and cheap price.

Therefore, reducing the quality of copper foil on the battery, reducing the cost of copper foil raw materials, while providing higher energy density, has become the key to copper foil for power lithium batteries.
