

It is important to note that some well pump systems may have two capacitors: a start capacitor and a run capacitor. The start capacitor is usually a smaller, black capacitor labeled with a range of numbers (e.g., 161-193 MFD), while the run capacitor is a larger, silver capacitor labeled with a UF number.
