If you don"t have battery storage, ... In some cases, yes, having batteries for solar energy storage can be an important part of a system. Having battery storage lets you use solar power 24/7, maximize savings from your system, and have reliable power during bad weather and grid outages.

But energy storage has a dirty secret. The way it's typically used in the US today, it enables more fossil-fueled energy and higher carbon emissions. Emissions are higher today than they would have been if no storage had ever been deployed in the US. This is not intrinsic to the technology, by any means.
