It uses standard cooling equipment, plus an energy storage tank to shift all or a portion of a building"s cooling needs to off-peak, night time hours. During off-peak hours, ice is made and stored inside IceBank energy storage tanks.

Chillers can be operated during off-peak hours when electricity demand is lower or when energy from renewable sources is more readily available.
