The project plans to install electric boilers and a microgrid consisting of a 21 MW solar array and a 20.5 MW battery energy storage system to reduce carbon dioxide emissions by an estimated 7,865 metric tons per year, reducing at least 75% and up to 90% of the pressing process CO2 emissions from natural gas boilers on site.

The largest category of projects are those with planning consented, totalling over 1.4GW in operational capacity. Planning for battery storage projects is a typically shorter process than the equivalent for wind and solar projects, with the next step for those with planning consent an application to the ESB or EirGrid for grid connection.



Because storage technologies will have the ability to substitute for or complement essentially all other elements of a power system, including generation, transmission, and demand response, these tools will be critical to electricity system designers, operators, and regulators in the future.

According to statistics from the CNESA global energy storage project database, by the end of 2019, accumulated operational electrical energy storage project capacity (including physical energy storage, electrochemical energy storage, and molten salt thermal storage) in China totaled 32.3 GW. Of this total, new operational capacity exceeded 1 GW.
