Disasters like the wildfires in California, Hurricane Maria and Hurricane Fiona in Puerto Rico, and the Texas winter storm of 2021 have caused catastrophic power outages that left communities without power for weeks or even months, demonstrating the importance of energy resilience for critical facilities and services.

The results indicate that the co-dispatch of mobile energy storage systems and repair crews can reduce the outage scale and duration in the power distribution system. For example, the DOE"s SunSmart program helped equip more than 100 schools with backup solar and storage systems. In response to power system vulnerabilities revealed by Superstorm Sandy, the New York Governor"s Office of Storm Recovery aims to place solar panels and energy storage systems in flood-prone areas.

The fire codes require battery energy storage systems to be certified to UL 9540, Energy Storage Systems and Equipment. Each major component - battery, power conversion system, and energy storage management system - must be certified to its own UL standard, and UL 9540 validates the proper integration of the complete system.
